In consideration for submitting School Board application, please note the following:

- **School Board Term** - Board Member terms are three (3) years.
- **School Board Eligibility**
 - Spouses of salaried St. Hubert School employees are not eligible for Board membership.
 - Those currently serving as a member of the Parish Pastoral Council or the Parish Finance Council or as a Parents' Club Officer/Committee Head or Athletic Board Members are not eligible for Board membership.
 - Membership is not limited to parents of students at St. Hubert Catholic School.
- **Monthly School Board Meetings** - The regular Board meeting shall be held on alternating months, generally the second Thursday at 7:30pm. Board members are also encouraged to attend Development Core Team meetings, as this is a sub-committee of the School Advisory Board. Meetings are held from August to June. When this date falls on a holiday, holy day or other special day, the meeting will be held at the earliest possible time. Attendance is required at Monthly Board Meetings.
- **Expectations of School Board Members**
 - The mission of the St. Hubert School Advisory Board is to encourage and foster a faith-based educational environment at St. Hubert Catholic School, providing leadership and communication among the administration, students, parents, and teachers. The School Advisory Board members provide counsel and advice to the pastor and the principal in the operation of the school. This includes policy, finance review and assistance in the overall development of the school in accordance with the direction set forth by the Archdiocese of Chicago.
 - School Board Members will actively participate in Board Standing Committees which currently are: BUDGET AND FINANCE, LEGISLATIVE ACTION, DEVELOPMENT CORE TEAM-Fundraising, Public Relations and Marketing, Student Recruitment and Retention, Alumni Relations. Additional ad hoc committees will be added as needed.
